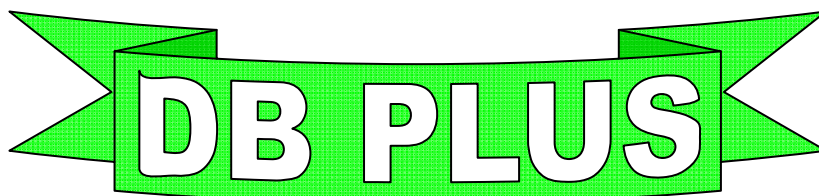

DB Plus is selective herbicide for control of broad-leaved weeds which can be applied to all varieties of winter and spring sown wheat, barley and oats undersown with red or white clover and direct re-seeds. It may also be applied to both newly-sown and established grassland.

Annual weeds will be best controlled if spraying is done while the majority of weeds are seedlings. Biennial and perennial weeds should be sprayed during their period of maximum growth – usually when the flower buds are beginning to form. The response of perennial weeds to treatment is often variable with only the aerial parts killed though suppression will often occur. The recovery of weeds will be reduced if the crop is growing vigorously at the time of treatment.

AT SEEDLING STAGE:

Annual Nettle	Orache
Annual Sowthistle	Pale Persicaria
Black Bindweed*	Poppy
Docks	Redshank
Fumitory	Runch
Groundsel	Treacle Mustard
Knotgrass	Wild Turnip

AT SEEDLING TO YOUNG PLANT:

Charlock
Fat Hen
Penycress
Shepherds Purse
Corn Buttercup

PERENNIAL WEEDS

Creeping Buttercup	- Before flowering – killer or stunted
Crowfoot	- Shoots only killed
Creeping Thistle	- Shoots 10-20cm high – shoots killed
Curled Docks	- Young plants killed or severely distorted
Broadleaved Docks	- Young plants killer or severely distorted
Horsetail	- Shoots only killed
Perennial Sow Thistle	- Shoots 10-20cm high – Shoots killed
Plantains	- Before flowering – killed
Stinging Nettle	- Shoots only killed
Speathitle	- Rosette to early bud stage - killed

Most satisfactory control of annual weeds is achieved by spraying at the seedling stage when weeds are dry and actively growing.
