Agrichem Seed Treatment Stewardship

BEFORE YOU DRILL

Please read this set of notes when you prepare your drill.

Other than your normal care when using crop protection treatments two specific areas to watch for are:

- Dust
- Uncovered drilled seeds and spillages.

Particular care must be taken as:

- Treated seed is very toxic to aquatic life.
- Treated seed **MUST NOT** be used as food or feed.
- Treated seed is harmful to game and wildlife. To protect birds/wild mammals, treated seed should not be left on the soil surface. Bury or remove spillages.

Some types of drills, especially precision vacuum types, emit air that can contain dust. Be aware that these drills require to vent onto or into the soil, or be modified to do so.

Thiram treated seed must be drilled and NOT APPLIED from the AIR or BROADCAST.

- The seed label will contain specific information relating to the crop type.
- It will also specify the variety and any dressing that has been applied.
- In addition to the above, the treated seed label may also carry advisory information for the end user on such issues as seed storage, drilling directions etc. as appropriate.
